

## **Recommendations from the Spring 2010 School Councils' Conference**

The following recommendations were discussed and approved at the School Councils Conference held in Whitehorse April 15 through 17, 2010

### **2010A01 Administrator/Teacher Evaluation**

We recommend that the Administrator Growth Plan committee explore ways to incorporate input from students and parents into the evaluation process for Administrators and Teachers.

### **2010A02 Student Engagement in learning**

We recommend that the School Growth Planning process encourage and support strategies to improve student engagement in their learning.

### **2010A03 Student engagement in School Growth Planning process**

Recognizing that the School Growth Planning process needs the involvement of students to be successful, we recommend that the Department work with School Councils and others to develop strategies and provide support to foster this involvement.

### **2010A04 Parent & Community engagement in School Growth Planning process**

Recognizing that the School Growth Planning process needs the involvement of parents and community for success, we recommend that the Department work with School Councils and others to develop strategies and provide support to these groups vital to student learning.

### **2010A05 Distance Learning**

We recommend that the Department work with Schools and School Councils to continue to develop and improve access to distance learning for courses and programming not available locally.

### **2010A06 Rural Access to Experiential Programs**

Whereas students from certain rural schools that attend experiential learning programs in Whitehorse are not given equal priority of access to student accommodation, we recommend that the Department review this policy to ensure that these barriers are removed.
