<ul style="list-style-type: none"> SCCS is offered to all Association member districts. Districts choose a two-week window during the survey open period. Districts sign an MOA and assign a District Coordinator. Districts have control over which sites and which students will participate (District Dashboard). Districts receive four or more weeks of preparation support from AASB. This includes: technical support, SCCS FAQs, sample documents for distribution, and survey instructions. Districts receive web addresses (urls) in advance of the survey opening. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> District Coordinators have access to student and staff participation rates 24/7 through an online District Dashboard. District administration receive three email updates on student and staff participation during the two-week window. AASB staff support district needs daily throughout the two-week window. Districts that elect to participate early in the survey open period have the option to extend their end date. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Districts can elect to receive early summary results (cleaned, but not analyzed data) in May. Districts receive full, analyzed reports in August. Results are sent to the School Board President and Superintendent. The Board and Superintendent decide the extent to which the results are shared. As part of their fee, districts receive up to a full day and evening of presentations from AASB staff. This is scheduled at the convenience of the district.
