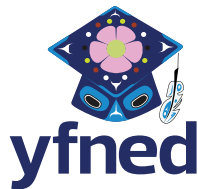


CRITICAL STEPS FOR THE FIRST NATION SCHOOL BOARD

1 Order-in-Council passed by Yukon Government on Feb. 11, 2021.

2 10 First Nations Chiefs sign First Nation School Board Agreement with Minister of Education.

3 One or more school councils pass a resolution to create the school board and dissolve the council.

4 Elections Yukon holds referendum in school council area. 50% plus one vote is required to advance the resolution.

5 Minister establishes the First Nation School Board (FNSB).

6 Elections Yukon holds election for 5 FNSB trustees. Candidates must be residents of Yukon whose ancestors spoke a Yukon First Nations language.

7 FNSB Trustees have the legal authority to appoint a CEO and may do this collaboratively with the Chiefs Committee on Education (CCOE).

8 FNSB negotiates funding allocation with Yukon government and sets timelines for implementation.

9 FNSB may establish and appoint representatives to their Community Committee, to work with the Board for the operation and management of its community school.
